

7th ANNUAL DURHAM JUNETEENTH CELEBRATION & UNITY MARCH

OVERVIEW

On Saturday, June 19 the 7th Annual Durham Juneteenth Celebration & Unity March - a festival and march, free and open to the public, will bring a multitude of organizations and citizens into the community in an effort to foster connections that will empower and uplift the community. Often cited as the African American Independence Day, the celebration of Juneteenth originates from Galveston, Texas, where on June 19th, 1865, the word of the Emancipation Proclamation reached the enslaved. North Carolina became the 27th state to recognize Juneteenth as a state holiday or a state holiday observance.

The 7th Annual Durham Juneteenth Celebration & Unity March will be held on June 18 on the CCB Plaza in Durham from 1 pm - 8 pm. This fun filled, educational and uplifting day begins with a procession at 12:30 pm with men marching with children (biological or not), church and school groups, athletic associations, boys and girls clubs, etc. Men have an opportunity to connect with the youth of Durham - allowing them the chance to forge a relationship that carries on after this event.

When the march ends at CCB Plaza, the Juneteenth Celebration begins. An Opening Ceremony includes songs, prayer, litany, elected officials and clergy, pouring of libation and salute to elders.

Entertainment throughout the day features national and local performers. Artists display and sell their arts in the Artist Pavilion. Vendors sell an array of African and African-American clothing, specialty items, crafts and delicious foods. The Health Fair includes blood pressure, cholesterol, diabetes, glaucoma and HIV screenings. Medical professionals from area health centers and hospitals are available for consultations. The Children's Village has games, face painting, crafts and other fun, educational activities and information for children of all ages.

Experts in their respective fields provide information, activities and demonstrations.

The 7th Annual Durham Juneteenth Celebration & Unity March has activities geared toward family participation, community unification and good old fashioned FUN!!

ORGANIZERS

The 7th Annual Durham Juneteenth Celebration & Unity March is organized by the Triangle Cultural Awareness (TriCA) Foundation Inc., a project of Congressional District Programs, Inc - a registered 501(c)(3) public charity. TriCA believes that festivals, parades and major public special events are an important part of the social and economic makeup of communities. TriCA plans events that create an opportunity for all community associations, ethnic groups and the economic leaders to work together for the benefit of their community. The major project activities of Triangle Cultural Awareness Foundation Inc. are conducted by Another Coley Event, which manages and coordinates all the details of the event.

7TH ANNUAL DURHAM JUNETEENTH CELEBRATION & UNITY MARCH

The 7th Annual Durham Juneteenth Celebration & Unity March will be held on Saturday June 18, 2011 in CCB Plaza from 1:00 pm until 8:00 pm. Vendors may sell, to include but not limited to, an array of African and African-American clothing, art and artifacts, specialty items, crafts and delicious foods.

The event is presented by Triangle Cultural Awareness Foundation and organized by Another Coley Event, a Durham-based full service event planning firm.

VENDOR SPACES:

- Merchandise and exhibitor booth space is 10' X 10'.
- Food vendor space is 15' X 10'.
- All vendor equipment, displays, stands, tents, tables and supplies must be provided by vendor and contained within this space. Spaces are very limited and available on a first-come-first-served basis.
- All vendor spaces are outside.

VENDOR FEES & PAYMENTS:

- **Exhibitor:** \$35.00
- **Merchandise vendor:** \$90.00
- **Food Vendor:** \$160.00
- NO TENTS OR TABLES WILL BE PROVIDED.
- All fees are non-refundable and **due by June 1st**.
- Please make payment by cashier's check or money order to: **Another Coley Event**
- If space is available after June 1st, a \$10.00 late fee will be charged for each booth rental.
- Vendor understands and agrees that he or she will assume full responsibility for all taxes, licenses etc. including sales tax on items sold.

VENDING INFORMATION:

- Booth vending times are from 1:00 pm until 8:00 pm.
- All set up begins at 9:00 am. No vendor will be permitted to set up prior to this time.
- Set up must be complete by 12:30 am and breakdown must be completed by 9:30 pm.
- Food vendors must have menus approved to ensure a variety of food choices.
- Mobile food units ONLY.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

All food vendors must present a Certificate of Liability Insurance with Triangle Cultural Awareness Foundation/Another Coley Event as insured.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:

- Durham County Health Department - Environmental Health Division requires all food vendors to complete a temporary Food Event Coordinators Application and pay \$75 in advance to the Durham County Health Department 8 days before the event. Please obtain application and/or more information by calling (919) 560-7800.
- Vendors will comply with all laws, ordinances, orders, decrees, rules and regulations of any lawful authority, agency or government unit which apply to the use of their vending during the Celebration, and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the organizers, its officers, directors, representatives, employees, agents, volunteers and sponsors for any penalties, fines, costs, expenses or damages.
- Vendors assume all responsibilities for any loss, damage, claim or other injury to the vendor, his or her employees, agents or representatives, or to any property or goods of the same, whether caused by fire, theft, act of God, accident or any cause whatsoever, for the period the vendor or his or her property or goods occupy the site and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Celebration, Triangle Cultural Awareness Foundation/Another Coley Event, City of Durham, their employees, agents and representatives from any and all such loss, damage, injury or other expense relating thereto.
- The Celebration will not refund any fees or expenses in the event of adverse weather.
- Vendor must restore space to its original condition. Cooking oil must be removed from the site during break down and cleanup. Trash must be put in receptacle.
- All vendors will be issued four (4) Juneteenth Celebration identification tags. Vendors will not be allowed to operate without these tags.
- Vendors will not distribute literature or provide any advertisement for any organization unless literature or advertisement is approved by the Celebration staff.
